Tarpon River Sidewalk Improvements

What is this City project?

The City of Fort Lauderdale is making safety improvements for people walking between Lewis Landing Park (SW 7th Street) and Davie Boulevard.

Improvements include-

- New Sidewalk along S.W. 9th Avenue between Davie Boulevard and S.W. 9th Street connecting to existing sidewalk towards Lewis Landing;
- American with Disabilities (ADA) improvements; and
- Crosswalk (pavement) markings at River Reach Dr. Intersection and S. W. 9th Street intersections.



- **What is the construction schedule?**

Sidewalk construction is expected to begin early May and construction expected to be completed in four to five weeks.

Construction crews will work Monday Through Friday, excluding holidays and weekends, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

What traffic impacts are expected during the construction?

Temporary lane closures are expected.

Two- weeks before construction, information will be available on City's LauderStreet.

Quiet Zone

Brightline has provided an update to the construction status of the quiet zone. The new completion date for construction is March 31, 2019. Once construction is complete, the Broward MPO will mail the Notice of Establishment, which initiates the mandatory 21 day waiting period, to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA).

Broward County Traffic Engineering is diligently working to replace the missing sign poles and fabricate new signage.
