## Progress on implementing Mobility Master Plan Priorities

### # 1, # 9 Sidewalks on SW 9<sup>th</sup> St & River Reach Entrance Improvements

- Finishing up Design now
- Quote in January
- Construction start in March or earlier
- Still working on new lighting

### #2 Paint Crosswalks

- SW 6<sup>th</sup> St & 7<sup>th</sup> at SW 4<sup>th</sup> Ave, done and with pedestrian crossing signals!

### # 5 Speed Signage program for SW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave

- Have had one sign rotating to 4 trouble spots since May. Permanent sign on SW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave should be installed by year end

### # 6, # 1 Sidewalks & Lighting on SW 7<sup>th</sup> St

### # 11 Traffic Calming, at SW 7<sup>th</sup> St & SW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave & SW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave & SW 9<sup>th</sup> St

**\$750 K Funding awarded by Broward MPO**

- Recycling Volunteers earned us \$1400 from city
- Held 4 Adopt-a-street Clean ups (earning NCIP points Neighborhood Community Investment Program) We currently have 25,500 points
- Two Party's in the Park and Neighborhood Wide Yard Sale
- Urged owner of house on the corner of SW 7<sup>th</sup> St & 4<sup>th</sup> Ave to fix up his property, sooner than later
- Developed an Emergency Preparedness Plan, established a working committee of residents, shared & collected information to & with residents.

**April**

- Two Little Libraries installed in Hardy Park and SW 9<sup>th</sup> Ave
- New speed hump on SW 7<sup>th</sup> St installed and repainting of existing humps

- FLP repaired and updated the Tarpon River monuments on SW 7<sup>th</sup> St at RR track
- Wrap on ATT Box on SW 7<sup>th</sup> St completed
