Update: Federal Courthouse in Ft. Lauderdale

The U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) has proposed three locations for a new federal courthouse.

1. Construction of the Courthouse at 301 N. Andrews Ave. (bounded by North Andrews Avenue, Northwest 4th Street, Northwest 1st Avenue and Northwest 2nd Street);
2. Construction of the Courthouse at 633 S. Federal Highway (bounded by Southeast 5th Terrace, Southeast 7th Street, Southeast 4th Avenue and Southeast 6th Street); and
3. Construction of the Courthouse at 477 S.W. 1st Ave. (bounded by Southwest 4th Street, Southwest 1st Avenue, Southwest 5th Street and Southwest Flagler Avenue)

Tarpon River - Health Assessment Update



At our last general meeting City Commissioner for our district Ben Sorenson mentioned the city's intend to pay for an assessment of our river's health.

"We are hiring a contractor to do a survey of the Tarpon River between SE 3 Ave to the west and SE 9 St to the east. That survey will assess the health of the Tarpon River and the amount, location and type of debris in the Tarpon River. Once we have those results and depending on those results, I will be pushing to have debris removal/mitigation work done in the river." - Ben Sorensen

Survey will begin Feb. 24th and core drilling (sampling) will start on March 2nd. We will continue to share updates as they come in.

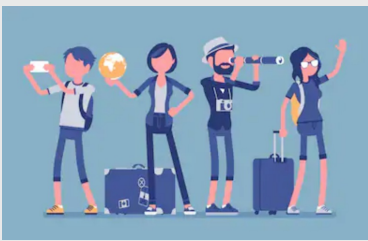
